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Midwifery Programmes



September 2016 intake:

- BSc (Hons) Midwifery (156 weeks) 48 students
- BSc (Hons) Midwifery (85 weeks) 20 students

Midwifery Programme



- Existing clinical documentation developed in 2011 fulfilling NMC Standards for preregistration Midwifery Education:
- Competencies and Essential skills clusters
- Grading of clinical practice
- EU Statutory requirements
- Timesheets
- Evaluation documents already active
- 7 trusts

Timeline of implementation

Implementation



- Student Workshops/Sessions prior to clinical placement
- All community teams accessed and P@RE discussed by ULL
- Follow on clinical areas identified by ULL and P@RE discussed.
- Mentor and student guidance
- Mentor allocation PEF/Clinical Coordinator

9 months in.....



- Pilot year
- Trouble shooting role with on-going surveillance
- Communication-P@RE, academic colleagues and trusts
- Amendment's following feedback from students, PEF's and mentors.
- High anxiety
